Our services focus on promoting abilities and encouraging independence.


Our Vision



Ability Connections is a fun, dynamic program offering participants great opportunities for further learning within all aspects of their lives.








Developing daily living skills is a high priority within the timetable including but not limited to moneys skills, shopping, cooking, communication, health and recreation, visual arts and computer programs.

The program focusses on communication needs; sensory and tactile experiences; physical and emotional well-being.








