Services is a flexible support option for people with disabilities

This new service is driven entirely by the needs and interests of the program's participants and aims to enhance quality of life by promoting choice, independence and community connectedness.



Individualised Services can support people to access the community and participate in activities of their choice.

This may be on an individual basis or as part of a small group depending on individual preferences.

We can support participants to reach their goals in a variety of key life areas based on their identified needs. Ultimately however the service is responsive to individual choice.

Some examples of flexible support programs include:

1. Recreation & Leisure:

Support to participate in your preferred recreational activities either individually or with a small group, at home or in the community, whether that be going to the movies, library, dining out, watching sport, socialising with friends or any other activity of your choice.



2. Community Support:

Support with shopping, banking, travel training, etc.



3. In Home Support:

Assistance with domestic tasks, independent living skills, personal care etc.



4. Further Education:

Support to attend Neighbourhood House or C.A.E. courses, etc. or other pre-vocational pursuits such as programs to practise your work skills, eg. Meals on Wheels, Lawn Mowing, Catering, Car-washing, Office work, etc.
