A “Neighbourhood House” style program and reflects a meeting place for people and the opportunity for skill development, community involvement and participation.

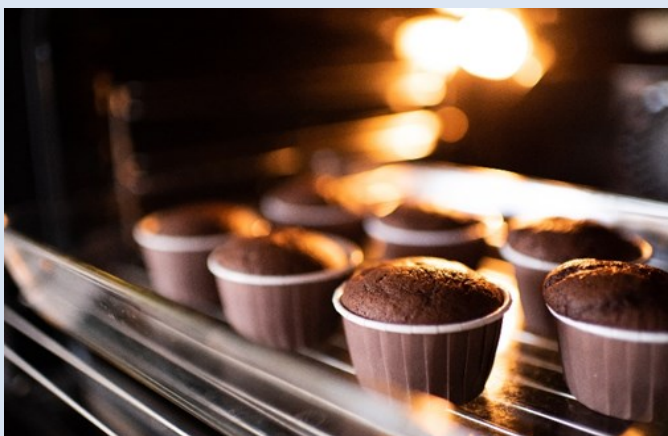
The main focus of this service is to empower people of all abilities to contribute to the local community.
